



# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Q: What are GROW Groups?

A: GROW Groups are made up of 12 to 20 people that meet at various times throughout the week in order to learn more about the Bible, grow in their faith, and meet some new friends along the way.

#### Q: When will my Group meet?

A: GROW Groups meet once a week, and each meeting is just sixty to ninety minutes long. Groups meet for about eight to ten times over the semester. It's a short-term commitment with a long-term impact on your life.

#### Q: Where will my Group meet?

A: Most of our groups will be meeting on our campus. Some may be entirely on Zoom.

#### Q: Do I have to be an "Expert" Christian to take a class?

A: Definitely NO, there are a variety of classes to help anyone at any stage in their faith, to follow Christ more. Some have an expectation of additional study during the week. Some read a book as a group, while others just ask you to commit to attend.

#### Q: What will the people in my group be like?

A: GROW Groups are made up of the same people that attend SpringLIfe on the weekends. You may see some familiar faces as well as some folks you are meeting for the first time. This is a great way to get to know people outside of a worship service.

#### Q: Is there childcare available?

A: Currently we only offer nursery and children's programming during the Sunday morning service.

#### Q: Do these classes cost money?

A: Some of the classes are reading books or have a recommended participant workbook which you would be asked to purchase. This is also a great way to be personally invested in your own faith development. Classes like our Cornerstones Series do not require any purchase of materials.

#### Q: What happens when I sign up?

A: When you sign up, the leader of your new GROW Group will contact you about the date and time the class will be starting as well as the specific location and any other information needed to have a great experience.

6 Weeks, Starts Feb. 20 Led by: Jim Dunn





8 Weeks, Starts Jan. 18 Led by: Mariann Eckman




